


Development

Objective happiness consists in health and education services, freedom and inclusion, rights and participation ...



Since 1972, instead of GNP (Gross National Product)
Bhutan has been using the index of Gross National
Happiness (GNH), which puts together:

- fair and sustainable economic development where growth means social benefits for all citizens
- conservation of the natural environment
- defense and promotion of national cultural identity
- good administration that can guarantee harmony in everyday life



Happiness and future generation

Jeffrey Sachs, a prestigious economist and Special Advisor to the UN Secretary General, albeit saying that considerable problems can be met in happiness measurement, also maintains that in any case it is worth trying because what is at stake is our happiness and the happiness

of the future generations.




Here is no individual self-determination social solidarity...
