

## YOUNG RESEARCHERS AWARDS

International Conference "Life design & Career counseling: Building hope and resilience". Padova, 20, 21 and 22 June 2013

The International Conference aims are, among others, promoting internalization and creating a network of people who, for diverse reasons, are interested in issues concerning working, vocational guidance, career education, career counseling and planning.

During the Conference two young researchers will be, then, awarded for their **excellent work** in Vocational Designing and Career Counseling field.

## How to apply and eligibility criteria

The competition is open to non-tenured Italian and non-Italian young researchers who earned their PhD degree (doctorate) after *March 1, 2010*. Researchers holding - at the moment of the application deadline (April 15, 2013) - a temporary teaching or research contract or a grant at public or private research institutes and universities or other institution of higher education are eligible. Tenured staff or faculty members cannot participate in the competition.

Applicants should submit the following documents:

- 1) a request to participate to the "Young Researchers Award" (indicating name, surname, date of birth, age, education and position), certifying satisfaction of eligibility criteria;
- a detailed description (in English language) of the research submitted to the selection procedure (no longer than 2000 words). This should include (a) an introduction, (b) hypotheses, (c) participants and measures, (d) procedure and data analysis, (e) results and (f) conclusions;
- 3) a CV.

Please submit the application electronically to <u>larios@unipd.it</u> **by April 15, 2013** and specify the object: Young Researchers Award.

Manuscripts will be evaluated by an *ad hoc* committee, chaired by prof. Salvatore Soresi and including five prominent international scholars, members of the Scientific Committee of the Conference. Participants will be notified the results of the selection procedure by April 30 2013.

Awards will be delivered to the winners by the president of the *European Society for Vocational Designing and Career Counseling* and by the Director of the *Larios Laboratory* of the University of Padova on Saturday June 22<sup>nd</sup>, during the morning closing session of the Conference.

Both awards include:

- a) free attendance of the Conference;
- b) presentation of the paper, as an oral presentation or poster, in a conference session;
- c) publication of the manuscript in the Conference Proceedings and in a subsequent international publication;
- d) a money price consisting in 1000,00 euro.
